On October 11, 2021, the Versailles town council met for their regular monthly meeting. Council members Mike Dougherty and Roxanne Meyer and attorney Lynn Flederman were in attendance. Minutes were recorded by Roxanne Meyer.

October 12, 2021 Versailles Town Council Meeting – Roxanne’s notes

In Kiersten’s absence, the reading and approval of the October meeting minutes were waived. These will be read and approved at the November meeting.

Ben Sieverding reported Versailles Fire Rescue responded to 52 calls in September and 21 more through October 12. Three members are active in First Response Support training and will start fire training in November. They visited with 435 children during Fire Prevention Week. They are still awaiting word about the \$136,000 grant for Fire Breathing apparatus. This equipment will expire on December 31st. Ben also reported that the campaign letter that was sent to all Versailles water customers generated \$4,135.

Council discussed current Ordinance violations. I asked if there was anything we could do about habitual offenders. Lynn recommended that we review the Ordinance and, if necessary, add language to curb this.

Randall reported that the new pick-up truck was scheduled to arrive on or around November 1, 2021. The down payment for this came from the Tyson Fund.

Council passed the Amended Budget 2-0.

Council discussed the large Duke transformer that was recently placed on Tyson Street near the Hassmer House. I shared my concern that it was very large that detracted from the landscape. I will get more information regarding the possibility of moving it and the cost involved.
