Fire Chief Ben Sieverding reported 685 calls for 2022 including 49 mutual aid calls.

He also mentioned the chirping on the state police post. Joe will talk to the police post. The ditch on Jason's property is holding water. Randall will call Mike Holman to come look at it.

Mary Ann Gay was in attendance and had concerns about drainage at the property behind her house. The council agreed to take a look at it and come up with a solution.

Bill Gay was in attendance and wanted to follow up on his daughter's water meter. Randall noted that it was already fixed.

Department reports were received prior to the meeting and were read and reviewed by council. Items on the consent agenda were accepted.

The protocol for Boil Water Advisories or Mandatory Notices was approved. Town will meet with EMA director to discuss use of Hyper-Reach.

Council discussed upgrades to Saw Mill And Graham Creek lift stations. Town will meet with Curry to discuss these lift stations.

The draft of the contract with the Ripley County Soccer Club for spring soccer camp was approved.

The job description for the new Code Ordinance Officer job was approved and the job listing will be posted in the newspaper.

Holly noted that our community does not offer many opportunities for our senior citizens. Her solution was to open the community center on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of the month from 1-3pm for a senior gathering. Games will be provided. The council approvad. The first gathering will be held on February 1, 2023.
