

October 14, 2025

On October 14, 2025, the Versailles Town Council met for their regular monthly meeting. All Council were in attendance along with attorney Lynn Fledderman. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

Solid Waste collection bids were received and opened. Council will request feedback from town residents before making a decision.

Jerad Amos was present to discuss needed improvements for the town's baseball and softball fields. He will collaborate with Josh Combs and Brian Linville to come up with a list of requested work to be completed.

Brian Linville was present to update council on the Cane's program. They have a tournament scheduled at the complex May 8-10, 2026. He also offered to let Ripley County Rec League run the concession stand for the tournament.

Department reports were received prior to the meeting and were read and reviewed by council. Items on the consent agenda were accepted.

The leak adjustment policy passed on 2nd^d read. The new policy will be in effect in 30 days.

Mr Sran was present to discuss updates made to the Nobel LLC property and his plans. He will attend the meeting next month with further updates.

Fleis & Vandenbrink are working on specifications for the new practice fields at the complex. The town will seek multiple bids.

Council unanimously approved a 3% increase for all employees in 2026. The salary ordinance will be signed at a future meeting.

Roxanne detailed future needs for the town's sewer system and discussed potential sewer rate raises. Fleis & Fandenbrink have evaluated the town's sewer system and have made recommendations to maintain and improve the current system.

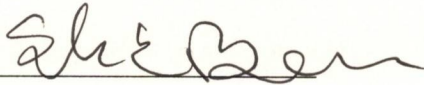

Lynn Fledderman reviewed the modifications for Chapters 28 & 32 ordinance updates. It passed the second reading.

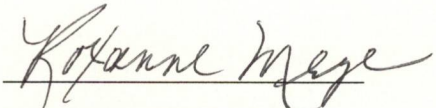
Laura Smart was approved to paint the windows at town hall for the Home for the Holidays Main Street Versailles event.

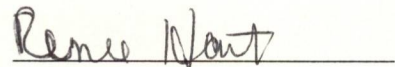
